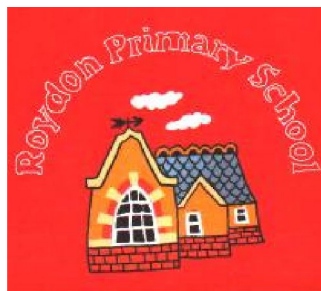

We will be thinking about what makes us special, what we are good at and who we admire and producing our own family shield.

In gymnastics we will be thinking about animal moves and creating sequences on and off equipment.

After looking at the weather in Australia, we will be searching our school grounds for signs of spring and creating spring pictures using a range of media.



The sounds of the traditional drums in Africa will lure us towards the end of the term. We will create African animals, masks, necklaces and shields, alongside learning about life in Africa and traditions in the continent.

In ICT we will be continuing with Espresso coding, and using games and apps on the iPads to support our learning.

We will use these to solve addition and subtraction problems, and investigating how 'lots of' can help us to solve multiplication and division problems. We will be learning to recognise and use coins, and naming different shapes and fractions.
