

Notice of scheme to improve and enlarge the accommodation at Roydon Primary School

Dear Residents,

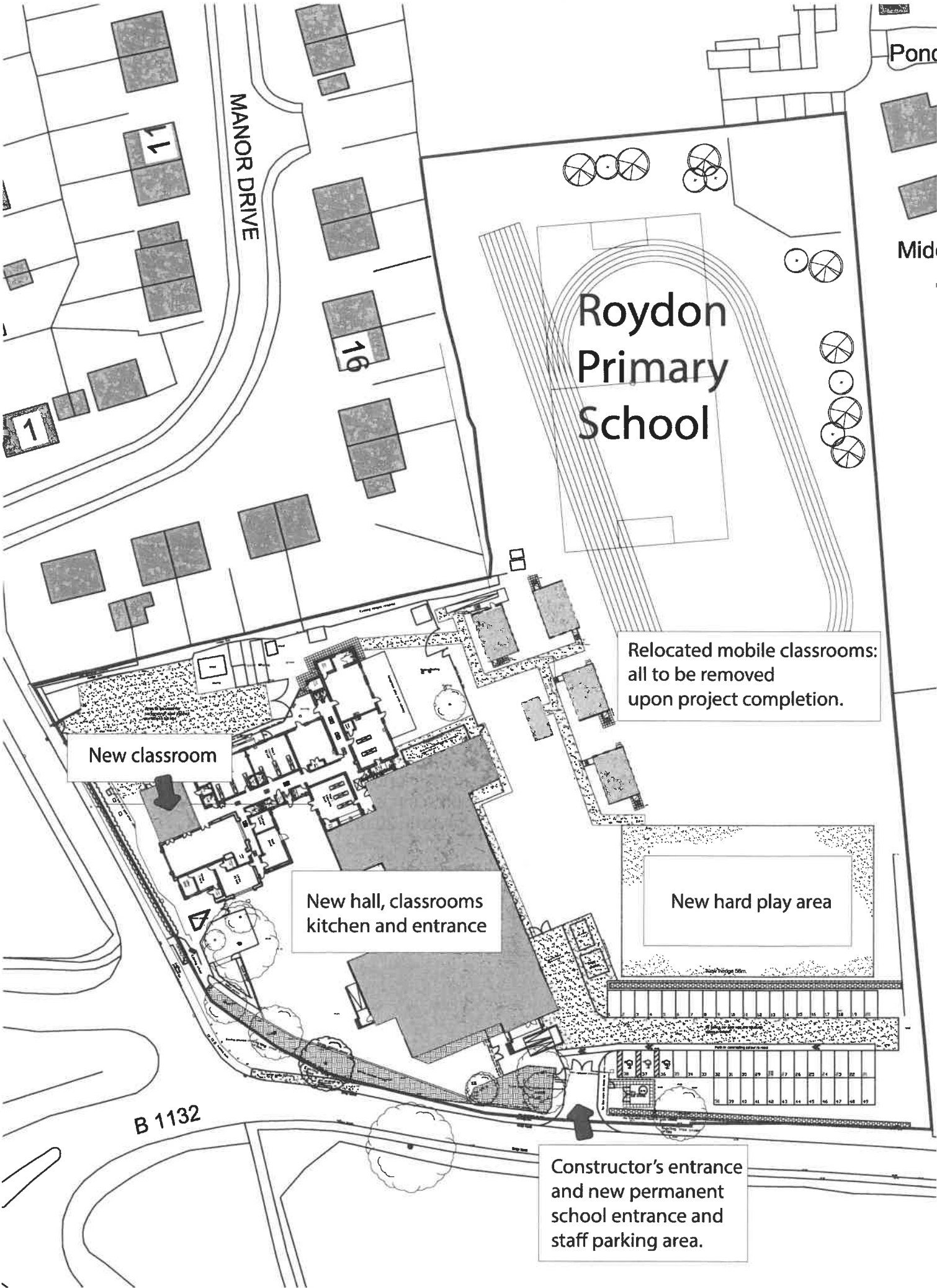
This letter is to make you aware that a Planning Application for Roydon Primary will shortly be submitted for consideration.

You may recall that in 2015 Children's Services first wrote to you to make you aware of our plans to expand Roydon Primary to a 420 places. Since then further design work has taken place and we are now at a point when we can submit our full planning application. After feedback the original proposal has been further refined and now omits the proposed separate four-classroom block on the eastern boundary. These rooms will still be built but on different parts of the site. The attached plan gives an indication of where the new build will be located.

The revised scheme now includes eight new classrooms and still retains, a new larger school hall, a new kitchen plus a new school car park and vehicle entrance. All the existing mobile units will be removed upon completion.

Once the planning application has been submitted there will be the usual opportunity for individuals and interested parties to express their views to the planning authority in the form of formal submissions. You should shortly receive a letter from Norfolk County Council Planning Services explain how comments can be submitted. If the application is approved, it is hoped work can begin over the summer with final completion scheduled for early 2019.
