Curriculum Content

For the first part of this term we will be studying Ancient Greece, learning about everyday life of the Greeks, including Myths and Legends. We also plan to celebrate our work through an Ancient Greek day.

After SATs we will run our **Enterprise Afternoon** that has been very successful in previous years. Children will be asked to form a company to either provide a service or sell a product. For the rest of the summer term we will be concentrating on our topic of 'Celebrations' linked to RE, planning Enterprise Afternoon and practising for Busking Day.
