


Roydon Primary School

Welcome back, everyone! We have a busy term ahead of us in Foxes, Rabbits and Kingfishers. We are writing to provide you with some information about what we will be doing between now and Christmas.

Our topic for the term will be Prehistoric Man which will be linked to different curriculum areas. English will be taught as a class, but children will be split into ability groups for phonics sessions. Throughout the course of the day all lessons are differentiated to suit the needs of the children. In maths, children have been divided into 3 groups so the children will be learning alongside others of a similar ability. These groups will be taught by Mrs Davies, Mrs Bennett, and Mrs Bowen and Mrs Birkinshaw.


If anyone is able to spare some time in an afternoon, or during registration to hear children read at school, this would be much appreciated. Please come in and see us.
