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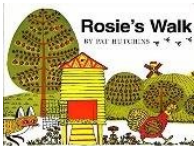
Summer Term in Hedgehogs & Woodpeckers

Farming

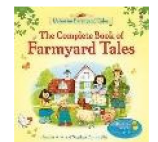
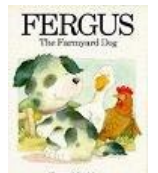
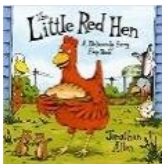
Our last half term!



Over the next few weeks we are going to be learning about farming with a walk to a local farm and a trip to the Norfolk Show.



Rosie's Walk will introduce our topic and the children will look at ordering and retelling a story. Fergus the Sheep Dog, Little Red Hen and the Usborne Farmyard Tales will continue our journey into the farming world.



In mathematics we will be recognising a coin's worth, buying and adding in our farm shop and using our subtraction skills to work out our change. Measuring mass and volume will help us when we are working on the farm, and consolidating our knowledge of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division will take us to the summer holidays.



Science will have a farming and growing focus and we will be looking at where our food comes from. We will also be learning about seasonal changes in our final season of the school year, summer.

We will be welcoming visitors from local preschools and nurseries, so in PSHE we will be looking at change, knowing ourselves, planning to reach goals and making changes.

In art and DT, we will be consolidating all of the skills we have learnt throughout the year in collage, making moving pictures and more. ICT will see us developing our coding skills and exploring a range of apps.
