

# MATHS

Well planned sequences of learning support children to develop and refine their maths skills

Children have methods for completing the four operations, and can apply these independently to problem solving situations

Children are fluent in recalling number facts

At the end of Year 6, children's attainment is at or above the national average



Children are reasoning with increased confidence and accuracy

Children have made expected progress or above, which is tracked using Pupil Asset
